Run Roit at Burlton Park in Katoch Shield

The Katoch Shield tie between Jalandhar and Mohali turned into a mountain of runs. Batting first Jalandhar posted 721 for 4 in 150 overs before declaring the innings. The Jalandhar run riot was led by wicket keeper Abhishek Gupta who hit a blistering unbeaten triple century (300) off 306 balls studded with 39 rousing boundaries and 6 huge sixes. He was ably supported by skipper Taruwar Kohli who notched a double hundred (211) off 387 balls with 26 boundaries and one six. Opener Pargat Singh was unlucky to miss a hundred getting out at 98 off 85 balls inclusive of 15 boundaries and four soaring sixes. Taruwar Kohli and Abhishek Gupta put on 406 runs for the 3rd wicket. For Mohali Jasinder Singh 2 for 257 was the most successful bowler. Replying Mohali posted 195 for 1 in 38 overs at close of 2nd day's play. Shubman Gill unbeaten 91 off 99 balls with 10 boundaries and two sixes and Abhijit Garg unbeaten 89 off 117 balls with 12 boundaries had put on 144 runs for the unbroken 2nd wicket. Subek Gill 1 for 30 was the only successful bowler for Jalandhar.
