## RAIN PLAY SPOIL SPORT IN 22<sup>nd</sup> ALL INDIA J.P. ATRAY MEMORIAL CRICKET TOURNAMENT QUARTER FINALS

In the first quarter final played at I.S. Bindra Stadium Mohali Reliance winning the toss against PCC chose to field. The match which started at 10.30 am due to wet outfield was once again halted at 12.30 pm with the skies opening up. In the meanwhile Punjab had mustered 136 for 2 in 28 overs.
