### Punjab State Inter-District Under-19 Men's One-Day Limited Overs Tournament Quarter Final matches-2022-23.

**The Punjab State Inter-District Under-19 Men's One-Day Limited Overs Tournament for 2022-23. The Quarter-final matches was played at various District Headquarters and detailed results are as under:**

**Patiala (Under-19 Men) vs Gurdaspur (Under-19 Men) – Patiala won by 8 wickets & enter into semi-finals.**

**Patiala (Under-19 Men) vs Gurdaspur (Under-19 Men)** match was played at Dhruv Pandove Cricket Ground, Patiala. Gurdaspur won the toss and elected to bat. Batting first Gurdaspur scored 175 for 8 in 50 overs. Shaksham Singh 45 off 76 with five boundaries and two sixes and Vikrant Sharma 44 off 53 with four boundaries and 1 six were the main run-getters for Gurdaspur. Aryan Yadav 3 for 27 and Damanpreet Singh 2 for 28 were the most successful wicket-takers for Patiala.

In reply, Patiala achieved the target of 176 in 41.5 overs. Anantvir Singh 88 off 125 with six boundaries and one six and Jaskirat Singh 36 off 61 with one boundary were the main run-getters for Patiala.
